On behalf of the members of the Canal Fulton Police Department, I am pleased to present the 2010 Annual Report to Mayor Grogan, City Council and the citizens of Canal Fulton.

Activity levels for 2010 were the highest in recent years with over five hundred more calls for service than last year, primarily as a result of changes in the way routine building security checks are reported. Canal Fulton Police Department's most significant event of the year occurred in mid-April, when an employee at a local business was shot and killed by a coworker. Although classified as a murder for statistical purposes, the defendant later plead guilty to reckless homicide and was sentenced to five years in prison.

In addition, two officers were recognized for their outstanding contributions during an early morning apartment complex fire in April. Officers Dennis Muntean and Robert Buhecker were awarded commendations for their quick thinking and bravery in alerting residents and evacuating the structure, possibly saving lives and preventing more significant property damage. They were assisted by Officer Edward Porter of the Lawrence Township Police Department.

Among our goals for 2011 are sustaining essential public safety services despite the current economic conditions, completing advanced collective training on critical incident operations, strengthening our relationships with adjacent law enforcement agencies, improving community outreach programs and pursuing affordable facility/equipment improvements.

As always, the men and women of the Canal Fulton Police Department appreciate your continued support and cooperation as we strive to make our community a safer place.




